Audrey Howell is a Junior attending Viewmont High School. She has studied piano with Catherine Brower Dean for 11 years. The week the pandemic was announced in the U.S., the Howells acquired a used Steinway, which almost made the lock-down exciting! Audrey regularly competes throughout the state and was recently awarded first place in the Ogden Piano Festival's concerto competition. She also studies trumpet with Jeff Novak and has been selected for the Utah All-State Band on both trumpet and piano. Audrey teaches piano in a studio she shares with her brother. She enjoys volunteering at Lakeview Hospital, serving as Centerville City Youth Council Mayor pro tem, and leading the Viewmont High Marching band as drum major.

Tonight, she's excited to perform a concerto by Beethoven, who is her 5th great grandfather in her piano teacher lineage.



Samuel Aston is a Senior graduating summa cum laude at Farmington High School. He began playing the cello in sixth grade in his school orchestra program and has loved it ever since. He has been studying cello with Rachel Wallin for four years. Samuel has been a member of both the Davis Youth Philharmonic and Utah Youth Philharmonic for several years. He has been selected for the All-State Orchestra three years in a row. He also plays the flute and was selected for the All-State band. Samuel is a Sterling Scholar finalist for instrumental performance. He plans on studying cello performance at BYU this fall. Outside of music, Samuel enjoys biking, rock climbing, camping, fishing, and anything outdoors.



Scheherazade is one of his favorite pieces for orchestra, and with all the amazing soloists performing tonight, it will truly be an unforgettable concert.

At just 17 years old, <u>Leah Kim Keyes</u> is quickly establishing herself as an emerging artist in the flute world. She performed as a soloist with the Utah Symphony at age 16 during its annual *Salute to Youth* concert. In 2024, she was awarded Grand Prize in the Southwest Symphony Young Artist Competition, where she performed the *Gordeli Concertino for Flute and Orchestra*. Her other concerto appearances include performances with the Utah Philharmonic, West Jordan Symphony, Lyceum Symphony, and the Orchestra of Southern Utah, the latter as a recipient of the Halversen Young Artist Award.



Leah began her flute studies at age 9 with Nancy Toone and currently studies with Catherine Boyack (NYC) and Lisa Byrnes of the Utah Symphony. She was recently accepted to attend the world-renowned Interlochen Arts Camp in Michigan this summer.

As a junior in High School, Leah serves as principal flutist in the Woods Cross High School Wind Ensemble, Davis Youth Philharmonic, and Lyceum Symphony in Salt Lake City. She is a six-time Utah Flute Association Sonata Competition first-place winner, a four-time State MTNA Solo Division winner, and a four-time State UMTA Concerto Competition winner. When she's not performing, Leah enjoys journaling, mountain biking, weightlifting, and caring for her leopard gecko.

<u>Jacob Thiriot</u> began violin studies at age 4 with his mom. He is a junior in high school and a dedicated violinist who has studied at the Gifted Music School for the past four years, where he performed both in orchestra and in string quartets in many professional settings. He is also a member of the Davis Youth Philharmonic and has attended prestigious summer programs including BYU Summerfest and BYU Musicians' Institute, refining his musical artistry.

He currently studies under Leann Morgan at Brigham Young University, and his playing has been recognized in several competitive settings. Most recently, he was named Concertmaster of the 2025 Utah All-State Full Orchestra. In 2024, he received Honorable Mention at the ASTA Solo Concerto Competition, and now he is serving as Principal Chair in this year's Utah Symphony Side-by-Side, performing alongside professional musicians.



Outside of music, Jacob enjoys hiking, running, and rock climbing. He brings the same amount of passion and focus to his hobbies as he does to music. He would like to continue his musical journey and pursue opportunities at an even higher level in the future.
